Can your child read one-syllable words that contain short, long (e.g., <i>ai, igh, oa</i>), and R-controlled (e.g., <i>ar, er, ir</i>) vowel sounds?		Age 5-7
Does your child recognize common blends (like <i>st, cr, pl</i>) and digraphs (like <i>ch, sh, th</i>)?		Age 5-7
Can your child decode (sound out) two-syllable words?		Age 6-8
Can your child understand and read possessive nouns and contractions?		Age 6-8
Can your child decode (sound out) words with common prefixes and suffixes?		Age 6-8
Can your child read simple chapter books (like <i>Penny and Her Marble</i> by Kevin Henkes or <i>Mouse Soup</i> by Arnold Lobel) and answer basic comprehension questions about the story?		Age 6-8

Notes:

- In the Age 4-5 level, all Kindergarten-level Reading standards are fully integrated into the daily unit studies.
- If you answered yes to all of these criteria, your child shouldn't need additional reading instruction.
- In the Age 7-9 level and beyond, our literature-based language arts program covers all Reading standards directly in the unit studies.
