

Age 6-8 Year-Round Schedule

Creating a year-round schedule for science, social studies, and language arts is easy. There are 12 units of curriculum and 12 months in the year. Aim to complete one unit each month. The math curriculum contains 10 units that vary in length, so use this chart to ensure you stay on track.

As you fill out the schedule, keep in mind any vacations or holidays that may be coming up. If you are going to take two weeks off in December, you should reflect that in your schedule.

As you work through the curriculum, aim to complete between 3 and 4 lessons each week. You can adjust your pace as you go through the year by tracking your progress on this schedule. The flexible nature of our curriculum puts you in charge of the schedule instead of the other way around.
